Hafa Adai and welcome to Guam!

I know the flight to Guam is long and tiring. Utmost on your mind is selecting a place to stay that fits your needs until you obtain permanent quarters. I hope this letter and its enclosure will assist you in that decision.

First, you need to know where the schools are located that your child(ren) may attend. There are four DoDEA Guam schools. Guam High School (GHS) at the Naval Hospital, McCool Elementary/Middle School (MEMS) on Naval Base Guam, Andersen Elementary School (AES) and Andersen Middle School (AMS) on Andersen Air Force Base. Families with students who meet the eligibility requirements as established by the United States Congress may attend our schools on a space-required basis. However, school bus transportation is limited to base housing areas and certain off base areas in the school commuting zone. My transportation staff has prepared a map and narrative to assist you in selecting the school(s) your child(ren) should attend based on your family's housing needs.

Additionally, while waiting for quarters, school bus transportation is available from many of the COMNAVMAR approved TLA hotels. Please note the hotels located in Tumon and Tamuning are in the Andersen Schools area, therefore transportation is available from only a few hotels to MEMS.

The staff at the School Bus Office at MEMS (339-2387) and AES (366-5467) can assist you with your transportation needs. If you need further assistance, please contact the District Office at 344-9581.
